3. Apply interventions based on clinical rationales and knowledge of the law and ethics.
4. Explain the complexities of home visits and other "out-of-office" experiences.
5. Review current standards of practice, code of ethics, and CA law in regard to boundaries in therapy.
6. Discuss how cultural factors influence the perception of boundary crossings.
